PROJECT	MUNICIPALITY	BRIEF STATEMENT OF PURPOSE	LVPC COMMENT
1. Official Map	Lower Macungie Township	First-time adoption of Official Map.	Generally consistent, with good promotion of street connectivity. Several parcels proposed as agricultural easements fall under Urban classification, which is not fully consistent. Also, the LVPC advises that the Township complete its work on the Southwestern Lehigh multi-municipal comp plan before approving the Official Map in order to maintain consistency.
2. Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission (PUC) Review	Alburtis Borough and Lower Macungie Township	Add 1.6-mile Second 138/69 kV Circuit on Existing Schoeneck/Victaulic Tap Lines.	Generally consistent, though any portion north of Moyer Road falls in Rural and would be inconsistent.
3. Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission (PUC) Review	Allen Township (Northampton) and North Whitehall Township (Lehigh)	Reconstruct 4.7 mi of Transmission Line to Interconnect New Siegfried Substation.	Inconsistent with County Comp plan: new substation site rests primarily within Farmland Preservation, and transmission line extensions will contend with natural features (floodplains, very steep slopes).
4. Zoning Ordinance Amendments	Bath Borough	Adding Mixed Use to existing Parking Overlay District.	Consistent w/ County Comprehensive Plan.
